

Neighborhood Outreach Coordinator Position Description

Children's Hunger Alliance (CHA)

CHA is a statewide nonprofit organization committed to feeding hungry minds and bodies and raising awareness of childhood hunger through education, advocacy, and service so children will be well nourished, healthy, and thrive. CHA's mission is to break the cycle of childhood hunger and obesity in Ohio's communities.

Neighborhood Outreach Coordinators will be CHA ambassadors for their neighborhood communities and will work to educate their neighborhood about the mission and services of CHA and work to increase advocacy and outreach for food access and health policy goals.

Key Position Responsibilities

- Operate independently from home and serve as Children's Hunger Alliance ambassadors in your neighborhood.
- Identify health and education related resources in your neighborhood to complete and maintain a comprehensive asset map of the Southwest Ohio region.
- Attend related events in your neighborhood representing CHA.
- Seek opportunities to expand the presence, outreach, and awareness of CHA and its mission and services.
- Mobilize and build a network of people interested and engaged in health policy and advocate and lobby for legislation to further the mission of CHA.
- Work with CHA staff to leverage neighborhood connections and contacts to create community partnerships and strategically align CHA with like-minded people and organizations.
- Attend monthly meetings with other Neighborhood Outreach Coordinators in the Cincinnati and Dayton regions and submit a weekly report of your completed activities and events.
